
Antoni Vereshchynskyi as the Chancellor of Lvivska Politekhnika during the Second World War







CHILDHOOD AND YOUTH

Born in Stasiowa Wola near Halych. He was the son of **Józef Wereszczyński** (1839-1925), a deputy of the Galician Regional Sejm (for 7 terms) and the Austrian State Council, who was also known as a lawyer and a landlord. He graduated from the Faculty of Law and Political Sciences of the Jan Kazimierz University (1902 – doktorat prawa).

ACADEMIC CAREER

Began to teach law in 1922 at the Faculty of Engineering. Then he achieved the title of extraordinary professor (1925) and ordinary professor (1930). It was 1925 when he took over the Department of Legal Sciences. He was elected as a Dean for the Faculty of Land and Marine Engineering.



THE CHANCELLOR AND THE SECOND WORLD WAR

He had been appointed as a Chancellor in the June of 1939 several months before the Red Army entered Lwów. He was dismissed (but he was engaged in a secret university teaching political sciences at home). He wasn't able to work at the University after the war as he didn't know Ukrainian good enough.

He even gave the public lecture on the actual problems of international politics called «The League of Nations» in 1939/1940. He was trying to make students aware of the history of a peace movement, the establishment of the League of Nations, its Charter, system and

activities in different fields, the protection of national minorities, International Labour Organization, The Locarno Treaties, The Kellogg-Briand Pact etc.



LAST YEARS OF HIS LIFE

Moved to Cracow in 1946. He headed the Department of Legal Sciences at Politechnika Śląska.
